Settlement Beautification Policy No. LPR-005-006***

Policy Statement

1. **The Fishing Lake Metis Settlement Land & Membership department provides the Settlement members with opportunities for settlement landscape beautification within the settlement area through the provision of information, assistance, and support of settlement beautification endeavours.**

Purpose

2.
 - (a) **To ensure fair and equal opportunities for resident settlement members.**
 - (b) **To ensure that improvement is made to settlement homestead lands within the settlement area.**
 - (c) **To ensure that efficient use is made of "Settlement Beautification" funds.**
 - (d) **To provide guidelines for Settlement Beautification within the settlement area**

Definitions

3. **In This Policy**

"Settlement Beautification" means the science of improvement of the soil, seeding of lawn seed, and the development of homestead yards used for improvement purposes

"CMT" means the Certificate of Metis Title.

"Council" means the Council of Fishing Lake Metis Settlement

"Homestead" means the land that the Members house is situated on and where the member resides.

"Settlement" means the Fishing Lake Metis Settlement.

- (e) **The minimum amount of black dirt that is accessible is on load (20 yards) per household however should here be a surplus of black dirt the member may access an additional load (20 yards) for a total amount of 40 yards of black dirt. In which the member will have to pay 50% upfront and sign a payback agreement for the additional 50% within the fiscal year. (total cost of 40 yards is \$600).**
- (f) **Anything else pertaining to this policy, must not exceed \$1000.00 which a 50% down payment is mandatory. Arrangements must be made for the remainder 50% which is to be paid within the fiscal year.**

Example: lawn ornaments, sidewalks, flowers, shrubs, fences, sheds, items that are for beautifying around the yard of the homestead with a certified CMT.

Penalties

When a member fails to adhere to the terms and conditions of this project that the member has entered into with the Fishing Lake Metis Settlement Land & Membership department and the remainder of the fiscal year has elapsed since the agreement was made.


- (a) **The member will then be disqualified from any other settlement projects/programs, that are offered until reimbursement has been accomplished.**
