Alberta Health Services– Alberta Cancer Prevention Legacy Fund

Deadline: August 23, 2019 at 4PM.

This role is a 24 month temporary position designed to provide required support for Indigenous (Métis Settlements) communities in northern Alberta to participate in the AHS Alberta Cancer Prevention and Legacy Fund "Alberta Healthy Community Approach" project. By bringing increased capacity, resources and availability of skills to communities and project teams, this role will aim to support the development and delivery of community-focused and culturally informed health promotion and prevention planning and implementation in a context of chronic diseases, including cancer. Core responsibilities of this position will include co-facilitation of skill building activities for the purposes of assessing gaps and strengths in relation to supportive community environments for chronic disease prevention (cancer); supporting project team members in the development, implementation and evaluation of community cancer prevention and screening action planning; establishing and liaising of trusting relationships amongst Community Action Team, community members and Elders, ACPLF support team and with special consideration for coordinating the work and activities of a 'Community Wellness Team'; and communication of information critical to the success of projects, such as community challenges and concerns related to project activities. A desired outcome of this temporary position is to provide evidence-based evaluative information to support operational support of the role beyond the duration of the projects.
